Welcome and Introduction

Agenda Item #1

Strengthening ICANN's Non-Policy Capabilities

- **Reviews Support and Accountability (RSA) Team:**
 - Supports the community by running the operation of reviews in coordination with subject matter experts.
 - Streamlines reviews to help enhance their impact.
- **Implementation Operations Team:**
 - Oversees the implementation of community-issued, Board-approved recommendations through collaborative and effective planning and delivery in a timely and sustainable manner.
 - Focuses on implementation of recommendations resulting from:
 - Specific Reviews (CCT, RDS, ATRT, SSR)
 - Cross-Community Working Groups (WS2, Auction Proceeds, etc.)
 - Special projects such as the Evolution of ICANN's Multistakeholder Model.
- These two teams work together to improve reviews and support cross-community work across the ICANN ecosystem.

Status of Specific Reviews

Second Security, Stability, and Resiliency Review (SSR2)

Status Update

- [Final Report](#) submitted to the ICANN Board on 25 January 2021.
- Recommendations are grouped into the following areas:
 - SSR1 implementation and intended effects;
 - Key stability issues within ICANN;
 - Contracts, compliance, and transparency around DNS abuse; and
 - Additional SSR-related concerns regarding the global DNS.
- Published for Public Comment to inform Board action (28 January - 8 April).
- 19 public comments received (see 'summary of public comments' [here](#)).
- The Board must consider the [Final Report](#) within six months of receipt (by 25 July 2021).

Status Update

- **Accepted Recommendations (17 total):**
 - Some recommendations fully or partially implemented.
 - Dependencies on SubPro, PDP, WG, and ongoing DNS abuse discussions.
 - Implementation Planning in progress.
- **Pending Recommendations (6 total):**
 - Dependencies on ongoing DNS abuse discussions.
 - Work in progress to address ICANN Board requests.
- **Pass-through Recommendations (14 total):**
 - Continue to monitor community's progress as updates become available.

Status Update

- **Accepted Recommendations (15 total):**
 - Some recommendations fully or partially implemented.
 - Dependencies on EPDP Phase 2.
 - Implementation Planning in progress.
- **Pending Recommendations (4 total):**
 - Dependencies on EPDP Phase 2.
- **Pass-through Recommendations (1 total):**
 - Continue to monitor community's progress as updates become available.

Status Update

- **Board Action on 30 November 2020**
 - Accepted Recommendations (5 total).
 - ICANN org is in the process of carrying out a preliminary evaluation of the potential work associated with implementation of the ATRT3 recommendations. This is being done for the purpose of evaluation during the upcoming prioritization exercise of ICANN's work.
 - Some recommendations in process of implementation.

Status of Organizational Reviews

Agenda Item #3

Key Developments

Current (second) cycle of Organizational Reviews is nearing completion.

- Fulfills Bylaws mandate and demonstrates accountability.
 - Implementation completed: GNSO, ALAC, and SSAC.
 - Implementation in progress: ccNSO, RSSAC, and NomCom Review Implementation Working Group.
- Lessons learned and community input to inform the next cycle.

Next cycle of Organizational Reviews offers an opportunity to improve outcomes.

- Impact of Board-approved ATRT3 recommendations on how Organizational Reviews will be conducted in the future.
 - Continuous Improvement Program and Holistic Review pilots.
- Timing of the next cycle of Organizational Reviews, starting with the third GNSO review, is scheduled to launch in June 2021.
 - ICANN Board to consider the deferral of the next GNSO Review, and
 - Proposal to more comprehensively address the next Organizational Review cycle in consultation with the ICANN community.

Status of Cross-Community Working Groups and Others

Agenda Item #4

Status of Work Stream 2 (WS2)

- **Status of Implementation (100+ recommendations)**

- Implementation underway.
- Planning for recommendations where implementation has not started.
- ICANN org supporting community groups.

- **WS2 continues to remain an area of priority for ICANN org.**

- A priority in FY 2021 (1 July - 30 June), and FY 2022 (1 July - 30 June).

Status of the Evolution of the Multistakeholder Model (MSM)

- **Six overarching issues identified by the community:**
 - Three (3) of the six (6) issues have been prioritized by the community for implementation in the immediate term.
 - Implementation Planning in progress.
 - Developing ‘Evaluation Methodology’ to monitor the progress of implementation of work items and assess the effectiveness of implementation in evolving ICANN’s multistakeholder model.
- Work is already taking place across the ICANN community that may comprehensively address community-identified priority topics and enhance the effective and efficient functioning of ICANN’s multistakeholder model.
- Implementation of the Enhancing the Multistakeholder Model project is not a stand-alone initiative. Rather, it is a holistic approach to evolve the multistakeholder model by encompassing all existing work efforts with the needs for future improvement.
