

ICANN Public Meeting Survey Results: Community Interest in Face-to-Face Meetings

This community survey was conducted to investigate the possibility of organizing ICANN72 as a hybrid meeting with virtual and in-person attendance in Seattle. The survey target audience was current virtual attendees and previous in-person attendees from the last 3 years.

A formal decision on whether ICANN72 is to be held in person will be considered by the ICANN Board in July 2021.

The Board will consider the results of this survey as an important part of its deliberations.

Final results as of 10 June 2021



Survey Results | Regional Breakdown (Q3) In what region do you live? 150 200 50 100 250 300 Africa (AF) 67 11% **Average Regional Attendance** Asia Pacific (AP) 101 19% Europe (EUR) 26% 153 Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) 8% North America (NA) 37% 146

2,079 average attendees since 2016, with 665 responses = 32% survey response rate





How many in-person ICANN Meetings have you attended in the past?







A. Reduced global diversity of in-person attendance due to COVID restrictions






Survey Results | Limited Attendance by Region - SO/AC

B. Limited in-person attendance by my SO/AC



C. Limited in-person attendance due to vaccination requirements





How important are the following safety protocols in your decision to attend an ICANN Public Meeting in person?







Survey Results

Global Considerations

- Current travel restrictions among countries
- US Visa availability with many embassies and consulates operating at reduced capacity
- Varying vaccine availability
- Varying COVID-19 infection rates

Timeline Considerations

- Mid-July decision date to accommodate:
 - Funded traveler visas and community travel arrangements
 - Venue and service provider contractual obligations

What do we mean by hybrid?

A "Hybrid" meeting embraces a more equitable approach to the different interaction types of in-person and virtual participants.

- Continued use of existing enhanced virtual participation tools
- Improved moderation of sessions ensuring equal participation by virtual attendees
- Better integration of in-person and virtual presenters
